SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

November 3, 2019 - At approximately 0100 hours, Sergeant Ramirez and Officer Sweeney received a service call regarding a fight at the rhythm room bar. Officers responded to the scene quickly and notified the caller to notify LAPD as well. LAPD and BID officers arrived at the scene at the same time. LAPD officers were able to locate the two parties who had engaged in a fight as described by the caller. Sergeant Ramirez and Officer Sweeny stood by and provide crowd control due to a small crowd that gathered at the scene. Both parties were arrested and transported shortly after by LAPD and cleared BID officers from the scene.

November 6, 2019 - At around 1005 hours, Sergeant Guzman and Officer Solorio were dispatched to a call regarding an individual armed with a dressing belt. Officers arrived at the corner of 7th and Main and immediately located the suspect striking cars with his belt. Officers told the man to drop his belt in which he refused. The suspect then turned his attention towards Sergeant Guzman and Officer Solorio. The suspect then began to charge at officers with his belt swinging in a combative stance. Officer Solorio retreated quickly and deployed his OC spray from a safe distance. Once the suspect was stunned, officers disarmed him and quickly apprehended him. LAPD was dispatched to the scene and interviewed multiple witnesses. LAPD then took custody of the individual and transported him for being under the influence.

November 10, 2019 - At about 1620 hours, Sergeant Ramos and officer Ajaa were on their routine patrol when they noticed an overturned vehicle on the corner of Winston and Main street. LAFD was already on scene attending to the driver of the overturn vehicle. LAPD arrived within minutes and tasked BID officers to provide traffic control. Sergeant Ramos and officer Ajaa rerouted all traffic towards Winston and Los Angeles street to give LAPD and LAFD enough space to render aid.

November 19, 2019 - Sergeant Ramirez and officer Sweeney received a service call regarding a disturbance at the down and out bar at about 0100 hours. When officers arrived at the scene, they were notified by the down and out security that a group of individuals were throwing glass bottles at them. BID officers then contacted LAPD in an effort to locate the suspects. Once LAPD arrived on scene, they were able to ID two of the six individuals who were scene throwing glass bottles. LAPD then took the two suspects in for ADW charges.

November 21, 2019 - At approximately 2300 hours, Sergeant Ramirez and Officer Solorio were on patrol when they noticed a huge LAFD presence on the corner of 6th and Main. When BID officers asked LAFD about the situation, LAFD notified BID officers that an individual had passed away due to an apparent overdose. BID officers stood by at the scene until properly cleared by LAPD.


November 29, 2019 - While on patrol at approximately 2130 hours, Sergeant Ramos noticed a huge LAPD presence over at the 300th block of 5th street. When asked, LAPD notified Sergeant Ramos that an individual had been shot in the alleyway. No suspect was apprehended at the time. When BID officers got the news, they went ahead and coordinated with nearby business. BID officers went ahead and notified the businesses to remain indoors until LAPD cleared the scene. The scene was cleared shortly after and all business operations resumed as normal.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS








Officers make sure they check on all quality of life issues.
