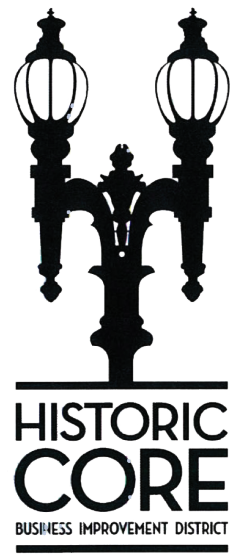


Street Report

SAFE AND FRIENDLY | OCTOBER 2019



The following data and information is provided to the Historic Core BID for tracking purposes. The information contained in this report is for activities reported in October 2019. The data and information is obtained from Ambassadors conducting patrols and entered in Statview.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

October 4, 2019 - At approximately 1850 hours, Sergeant Ramos and Officer Solorio were on their routine patrol when they noticed a suspicious male pacing back and forth on the corner of 6th and Main. Upon a consensual meet with officers, the suspicious individual began making criminal threats against the officers and brandished a knife. Without hesitation, officers contacted LAPD for assistance. LAPD was dispatched to their location and identified the suspicious male. After a cursory search, LAPD located a knife in the suspect's pocket. LAPD took the individual in for criminal threats and cleared our officers from the scene as victims.

October 8, 2019 - At around 0010 hours, Sergeant Ramirez and officer Sweeney were flagged down in front of 514 S Broadway by a concerned citizen. The citizen stated that he saw the group sitting down, about 20 feet from their location, smoking crystal meth. Officers walked over to the group of people sitting down and casually conversated with them. After 5 minutes of dialogue, officers determined that the subjects were all under the influence. Sergeant Ramirez then asked the group to leave in which they complied instantly. Officers then stayed posted on scene to ensure the group of people did not return back to the location.

October 14 2019 - At about 0600 hours, Sergeant Ramirez and officer Sweeney received a service call regarding an individual being chased by a suspect with a knife on the corner of 5th and Broadway. Officers immediately responded to the location and found LAPD units on scene. When asked, LAPD confirmed that the suspect was the one who was chasing the victim initially. Sergeant Ramirez then made contact with the victim and told him that LAPD will take care of the situation. Sergeant Ramirez and officer Sweeney also provided safety tips for the victim in the event that he is out on the street walking his dog again.

October 19, 2019 - While patrolling on the west end of the district, at approximately 0200 hours, Captain Pacheco and Sergeant Perchlak located a trash fire on the North west corner of 7th and Broadway. After several attempts to put out the fire were unsuccessful, Sergeant Perchlak placed a service call to LAFD for

assistance. LAFD arrived within minutes and helped extinguish the small blaze.

October 23, 2019 - At approximately 1925 hours, Sergeant Ramos received a service call regarding a naked man on the corner of 5th and Broadway. Upon arrival, sergeant Ramos located the individual on the middle of the street and attempted to redirect him back to the sidewalk. Being that the individual was very uncooperative, Sergeant Ramos called LAPD for assistance. LAPD arrived on scene and attempted to talk to the individual as well. Being that the individual showed signs of acting under the influence, LAPD arrested him right away. Sergeant Ramos provided crowd control support and was cleared from the scene once LAPD transported the individual.

October 30, 2019 - At approximately 0300 hours, Captain Pacheco and Sergeant Perchlak received a service call regarding an assault at the corner of 6th and Spring. Officers responded code 3 and located the victim bleeding moderately from a laceration to the side of her head. LAFD was contacted while Captain Pacheco and Sergeant Pechlak set up a perimeter. Unable to locate a suspect, officers returned to the location of the victim along with LAPD and paramedics on scene. The victim was treated by paramedics and released within minutes. The victim was able to provide a description to LAPD and the Safety team in the event that officers encounter the suspect while on patrol. This case is still pending.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

October 9, 2019 - At approximately 1700 hours, Sergeant Ramos and Officer Cruz received a service call regarding an unattended gun on a metro transit bus. Sergeant Ramos notified the caller to call LAPD right away while they traveled to the location. Officers intercepted the bus on the 400th block of spring street shortly after. Sergeant Ramos and officer Cruz then secured the scene/bus and waited for LAPD to arrive. Within minutes, two LAPD bike officers arrived and conducted their investigation along with interviews. Officers then thanked Sergeant Ramos and officer Cruz for their assistance in securing the unattended gun. LAPD also confirmed that the gun was real and loaded.

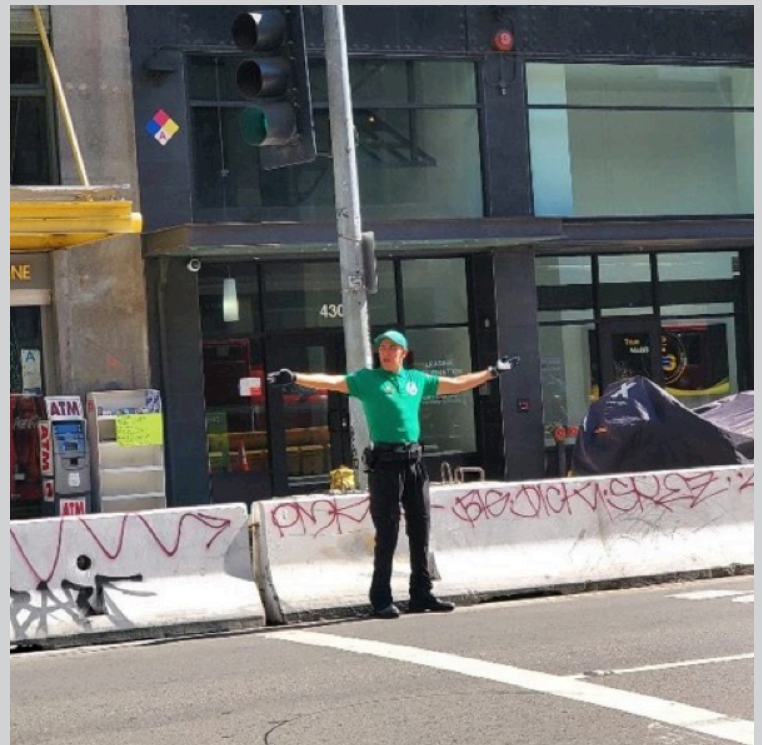

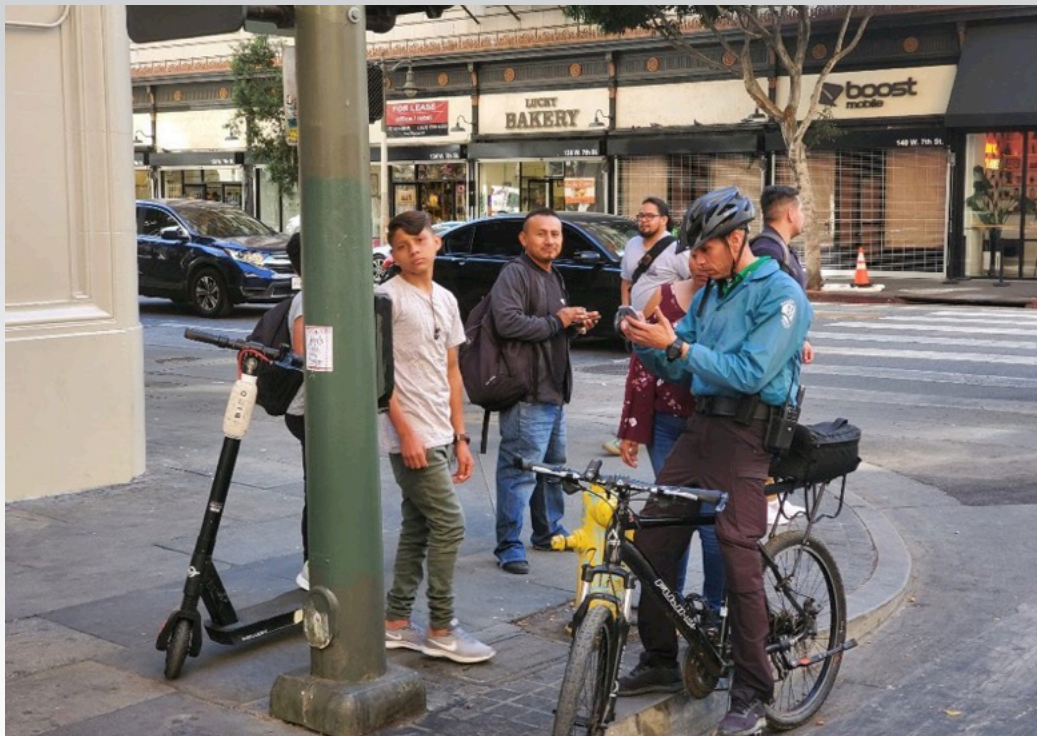

Sergeant Guzman is giving out directions to a family who is visiting downtown.

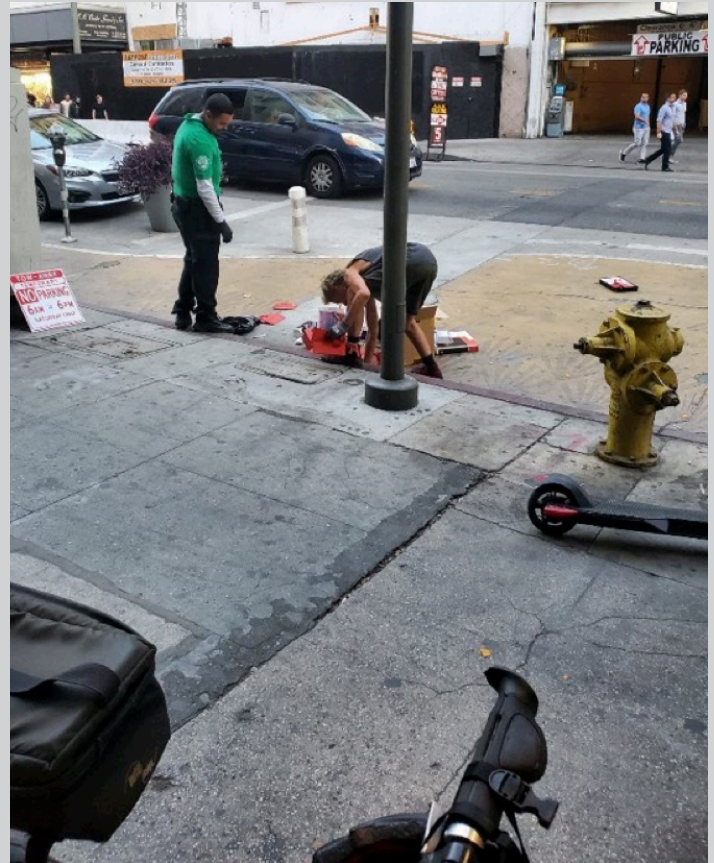
