Significant Incidents

December 2022

December 2nd

At around 0948 hours, Lieutenant Harbour received a call for service at Los Angeles Theatre Center, regarding an occupant that was making threats to the security guard from the building. Upon arrival, Lt. Harbour reported He was approached by the occupant aggressively. Lt. Harbour immediately called for backup (Officer Gayle) for assistance. Officer Gayle, immediately contacted LAPD. Lt Said upon LAPD arrival they assess the situation and proceeded to make contact.

December 8th

While on patrol at 1015 hours, Officer Gayle, He received a call for service regarding two individuals blocking the exit from the building on (address). Upon officer, Gayle arrival he said he proceeded to make contact with both individuals who were refusing to relocate. with Officer Gayle training and professionalism, was able to have both individuals cooperate and relocate. no further incidents was reported.

December 14th

At around 1948 hours, Officer Dawson received a service call for a medical response possible (overdose) in front of the business. Officer Dawson said upon his arrival, immediately attempted to make contact with the victim that was laying on the ground, but there was no response. Officer Dawson, immediately contacted LAFD, and his immediate supervisor Captain Aguilar. Officer Dawson said Capt. Aguilar arrived at the location and proceeded with CPR. Officer Dawson said LAFD arrived evaluated the victim and proceed to transport the victim to the nearest medical facility.

December 16th

At approximately 0530 hours while patrolling HC District, Officers Buckley, Harbour, and Ortega said they observed a fire on the street sidewalk that was caused by burning cardboard. Officer Buckley said they immediately exit the vehicle and try to extinguish the fire. officer Ortega said he call LAFD due to the fire was out of control. Officer Ortega said LAFD arrived on the scene and extinguish the fire within minutes, no further damages were reported.

December 19th

At approximately 0158 hours, Officer Ortega said he was flagged down in front of 632 S Broadway by a pedestrian reporting to him that a newspaper box was intentionally set on fire by an unknown suspect. Officer Ortega said he immediately exit the patrol vehicle to begin extinguishing the fire. Officer Ortega said he remain on the scene to ensure the fire was completely extinguished. he reported no further property damages.

December 21

While Sergeant Garcia, Garcia was on his routine patrol, He said He received a service call from the Clean team about an unknown male who was trespassing on 460 S Spring St (5th St side), He also said the clean advise him that the unknown male was grabbing art items from businesses and setting them on fire. He said upon arrival both the safety team and the clean team worked together to secure items and extinguish all fires.

December 22nd

At approximately 1118 hours. Sergeant Ajaa, Ajaa reported He was patrolling the HC District when he observed an illegal encampment in front of 449 S Broadway. Sgt. Ajaa said He made contact with the owners of the tent. He also said the other Occupants were very aggressive towards him, Sgt. Ajaa said with his training and professionalism he was able to remain calm and de-escalate the situation and had occupants from the tent relocate.

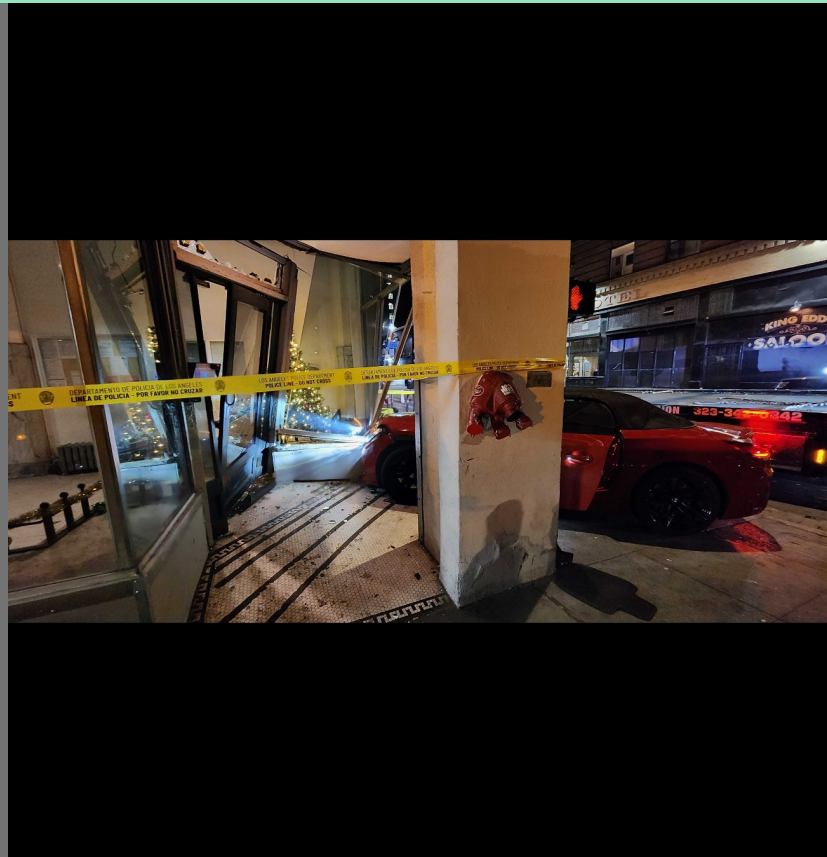
