Significant Incidents

November 2022

November 10th

At approximately 9:28 pm Officer Garcia got flagged down at 408 S Spring for an AA Male subject who had physically assaulted a female subject. The victim requested a safety escort to her residential apartment outside meanwhile her roommate arrived home and gave her access to the apartment complex. He offered to contact LAPD for assistance however subject declined and only requested a safety escort and for uniform presence.

November 12th

At approximately 0212 while on patrol officers Buckley spotted 3 individuals at 518 S Broadway climbing the building and performing graffiti. PSO Novales then proceeded to contact LAPD as I warned and advised subjects to stop vandalizing and climbing the building. Subjects then climbed off of the building and into their car, Subject drove off South on Broadway leaving the district everything was reported to LAPD.

November 14th

While on patrol Officer Buckley and C1 noticed a white male in from 640 S Broadway that was laying on the sidewalk. We then made contact with the subject. The subject then reported to us that he was unable to walk due to his wheelchair being taken and that he had pain in both legs. We then proceeded to contact LAFD. LAFD arrived on the scene and evaluated the subject. The subject then declined all assistance and LAFD walk away from the location.

November 16th

While Officer Banuelo and Officer Willis were on Patrol they heard a Hispanic male being 415v at the entrance of Spring St. Park. They both decided to code 5 from a distance and see if he did anything else. After 5 minutes the individual remained 415v but wasn't doing much else. Soon after the sub relocated southbound on Spring St. Everything was ok no further incidents.

November 18th

While Officer Aguirre was on patrol on 5th and Los Angeles, He noticed a AA male carrying a box and in the box, a bag full of paper AA male sat down on the public sidewalk and lit it on fire. Sub relocated south on Los Angeles. The fire was immediately distinguished with no further incident.

November 20th

While Lieutenant Harbour was patrolling the farmer's Market, he noticed a vendor receiving medical assistance. Made contact to see what was going on he was told another vendor was having a seizure. he immediately assist in calling LAFD and got medical attention. the patient was transported to a local hospital.

November 21th

While LT. Harbour was patrolling Broadway fourth Street He noticed a trash can on Frank court was on fire. He immediately pulled into the alleyway to assist the maintenance crew in putting out the fire since they were already there doing what they could. Everything was ok. the fire was neutralized. A second fire was reported next to the Alexandria LAFD was also called and was neutralized.

November 23rd

While LT Harbour was patrolling the district, the citizen app notified him that there were possible shots fired on Main and 5th. When He arrived on the scene He was able to talk to LAPD. LAPD informed me the shots fired were false. Instead, there was a structure fire at the Roslyn hotel 112 w 5th st. LAFD was trying to get inside. further information to follow.
