Significant Incidents



July 2023

July 2, 2023

At approximately 9:00 PM, during the patrol, a Historic Core Safety officer encountered female displaying signs of mental distress. She stood in the middle of the 5th and Broadway intersection, refusing to budge. The officer persistently encouraged her to relocate, and she eventually complied by moving to the sidewalk. Afterward, she departed the Historic Core district.

July 5, 2023

At approximately 2:00 PM, a Historic Core Safety officer responded to a hotline report of a possible attempted robbery in the 400 block of S. Los Angeles. The officers spoke with the business owners, who described an incident where a man tried to grab money from the cash register. While LAPD wasn't contacted, the safety officers closely observed the situation, tracking the subject as he exited the district.

July 8, 2023

At approximately 2:00 PM, a Historic Core Safety officer responded to a hotline report of an attempted robbery on S. Los Angeles St. The officers spoke with the business owners, who shared that a man tried to grab money from the cash register. While LAPD wasn't contacted, the safety officers closely monitored the situation and trailed the subject as he left the area.

July 11, 2023

At approximately 1:40 AM, a Historic Core Safety officer on eastbound 6th St. witnessed a physical altercation between two individuals on W 6th St. One person was knocked down, and the other fled northbound on Broadway St. A bystander dialed 911, prompting the arrival of paramedics and LAPD to offer assistance and handle the situation.

July 15, 2023

At approximately 3:23 AM, a Historic Core Safety officer observed an individual with a sword at 6th and Spring. The officer closely monitored the situation and followed the individual at a safe distance until they were out of the Historic Core district. In order to alert the next Business Improvement District (BID) about the situation, a call was made to provide them with a heads-up regarding the individual entering their district.

July 17, 2023

At approximately 3:00 PM, the Historic Core Safety team received a hotline call requesting assistance with relocating an individual in a wheelchair who was causing a disturbance. Upon arriving at the scene, the individual was approached and advised to move from the area.

July 20 , 2023

At approximately 08:45 AM, a Historic Core safety officer observed multiple scooters scattered and obstructing the sidewalk on patrol. The safety officer was able to organize the scooters nicely alongside the sidewalk.

July 23, 2023

At approximately 11:50 PM, during a patrol, Historic Core Safety officers noticed a man attempting to vandalize a city street sign. The officers intervened and were able to stop the man before significant damage was caused to the sign. The officer's prompt action in preventing vandalism helps maintain the appearance and integrity of the sign.
