



SAFETY REPORT OCTOBER 2023

On October 2, 2023, a Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) officer received a call from the Historic Core clean team, seeking assistance at the intersection of Broadway and 8th Street. They reported a male individual who was unwilling to vacate the premises, hindering the clean-up efforts. The responding BID officers successfully persuaded the gentleman to depart from the location, allowing the clean team to proceed with their task of tidying up the area.

On October 6, 2023, at approximately 7:25 PM, a Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) officer responded to a service call concerning an individual obstructing the entrance to a business on 7th Street. Upon arrival, The BID officer engaged with the individual and requested that he move elsewhere. This individual is recognized for being highly confrontational and has a history of altercations with BID officers. On this occasion, he promptly stood up, began shouting, and hurled a bottle onto the floor then walked away from the area.

On October 8, 2023, at approximately 4:44 AM, during a routine patrol, a Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) officer spotted an individual igniting a fire in the 500 block of 5th street. As the officer approached, they promptly extinguished the small fire. The gentleman expressed frustration and proceeded to use a torch in an attempt to set his pants ablaze. However, his efforts proved unsuccessful, prompting him to move to a different location.

On October 12,2023, at approximately 11:30 AM, a Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) officer received a call at the 600 block of Spring St. regarding a person yelling and screaming on the corner. When the BID officers arrived they saw him sitting on the ground yelling and screaming. The BID officer attempted to calm him down by speaking to the man calmly. It was determined that the man may have needed some medical attention. LAFD was contacted. They man was evaluated and taken in for medical attention.

On October 15, 2023, at approximately 3:17 PM, a Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) officer responded to a service call concerning individuals loitering. Upon arrival, it was determined that these individuals has a history of drug use and persistent loitering within the district. They were approached and instructed to vacate the area. Without resistance, they complied and departed without any additional complication

On October 18, 2023, during a routine patrol, a Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) officer encountered an encampment obstructing the sidewalk on the 800 block of S Hill. The officer engaged with the male individual residing within the encampment. The subject was cautioned and informed of the violation. He promptly disassembled the encampment and moved north on Hill St. The situation resolved smoothly without any complications.

On October 28, 2023, at approximately 2:00 PM, officers from the Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) noticed a substantial protest approaching the district. The group proceeded through sections of Spring, Broadway, and Hill, eventually exiting the district before circling back through the Historic Core District. The BID officers collaborated to vigilantly monitor the sizable crowd of participants.

On October 29, 2023, officers from the Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID) witnessed a group of individuals joyfully and calmly cycling through the district. They were observed laughing and enjoying music at a reasonable volume. The officers kept a watchful eye on the group as they rode through the district






















